



Dan. 12:4 The Angel Gabriel instructed Daniel:

Dan. 12: 4, 8-13 Shut up the words and seal the book until: THE TIME OF THE END Dan 12: 4, 6,7,9 relates the "time of the end" to the end of the period "a time, times & 1/2 a time." 1798

The vision of Dan. 8:13, 14, 26, 27, pertaining to the 2300-day prophecy and the cleansing of the heavenly sanctuary is sealed up until the time of the end. TIME OF THE END

Dan. 12:7: It will be for a Time, Times & 1/2 Time Answer: 538 — 1260 prophetic years — 1798

DAN. 12: 6-9 HOW LONG TO THE END OF THESE WONDERS? Answer: 538 — Until the TIME OF THE END — 1798

Dan. 12:11: Answer: 508 — 1290 prophetic Days or 1290 years — 1798 From the time the Daily Sacrifice [Pagan Worship] is taken away even in order to set up the abomination that makes desolate there shall be:

DAN. 12: 8-11 WHAT SHALL BE THE END OF THESE THINGS? Answer: 508 — 1290 prophetic Days or 1290 years — 1798 The period of suppression of ancient paganism

Dan. 12: 12, 13 508 Blessed is he that waits and comes to the end of the 1843 1844 1335 prophetic days or 1335 years Dan. 12:12 The 2300-year prophecy of Daniel, which ended in Oct. 1844, fully understood by 1843

Dan. 12:3 The wise - the people of God with special insight on the prophecies - instruct and turn many to righteousness

Dan. 12:4 Knowledge shall be increased This can be understood in two ways:

1. A reference to biblical knowledge and prophetic knowledge. After the Papacy fell in 1798 men began to study the prophecies to see if the prophets foretold that event. The result was the Great Advent Awakening. Using the books of Daniel and Revelation, men began to preach the Second Coming of Christ.
2. As a reference to general and scientific knowledge: After 1798 almost all the great advances in modern science and technology can be dated. From the abacus to the computer. From Pony Express to the fax machines and the cell phones.

Dan. 12:2 Men shall run to and fro The righteous resurrected to everlasting life. The wicked resurrected to everlasting shame

Dan. 12:9 The righteous, written in the books of heaven, are delivered from the wicked
